two-piece sleeve with center seam
variant to obtain wide shoulders and deep armholes
regular skirt base;
circular skirt base;

trouser-skirt base;
regular trouser base;
variant with insertion of folds
simple blouson base closed up to the neck;
Burberry's collar with stand;
jacket sleeve;
plain breasted jacket base;
sleeve construction: two-piece sleeve;
double breasted racket base;
procedure for increasing and reducing the outerwear fit
